Mr. Petrie has led the transformation of California's workforce development system in an effort to refine and replace California's workforce training, case management, data collection and reporting system, re-engineered the Unemployment Insurance Branch's re-employment services and eligibility assessment program, initiated the Unemployment Navigator service in local America's Job Centers of California (AJCC) and successfully implemented the federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act across the State. Mr. Petrie is also a long-standing active member of the California Workforce Connection organization.
